About Mini K.I.D.S....

Aspiring performers will enroll in a 10 week drama program that will help to develop self-confidence and improve communication skills. As students stage a small scale musical, they will be both challenged and encouraged to explore their creative potential in a non-competitive environment.

Each week, students will engage in acting exercises, theater games, ensemble singing, and movement. This session is an introduction to K.I.D.S. and will focus on the process of theatre in preparation for the regular 16 week K.I.D.S. program for grades 3, 4, & 5.

The 10 week Mini K.I.D.S. program will culminate with family and friends invited to the final class for a 30 minute performance of **DINOSTARS!**

About the Directors

Stevie Brouillet has been an educator in the Howard County School System since 1976 and has directed, staged, and choreographed countless musical theater productions ranging from pre-school to high school. In addition to being the founding director and owner of K.I.D.S. LLC, she has most recently served as the musical director for the *Young Columbians*, a professional touring ensemble under the auspices of Columbia Center for Theatrical Arts.

He also has taught at Columbia Center for Theatrical Arts, Creative Artists Institute, and Creative Cauldron. Mr. Boehm is currently choreographing all of Centennial High School's productions. Mr. Boehm graduated from The Catholic University of America, Bachelor's in Music with a concentration in Musical Theatre.

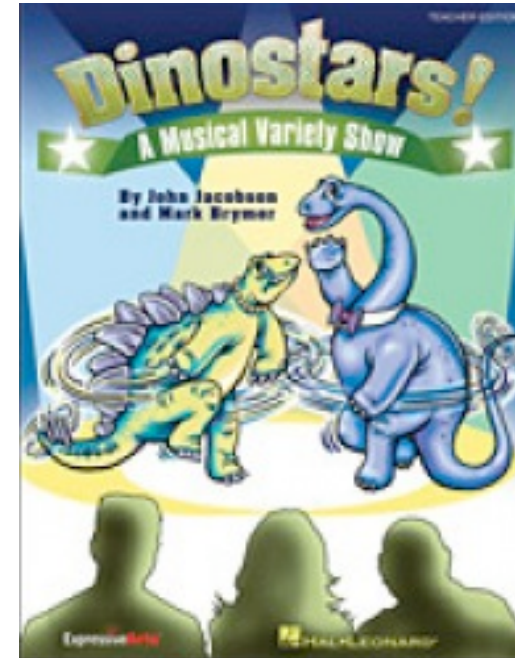
